



Northampton Community College and Cedar Crest College

DUAL ADMISSIONS INTENT FORM

Northampton Community College ("Northampton") and Cedar Crest College ("Cedar Crest") enter into this Dual Admissions Agreement ("Agreement") so that students completing an Associate's degree at NCC will be admitted to Cedar Crest with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0; complete a "Dual Admissions Intent" form; and satisfy all other Cedar Crest College transfer requirements. By satisfying the conditions of the Dual Admissions Agreement, Cedar Crest College will do the following:

- 1. Waive the \$35 admissions application fee.
- 2. Award academic scholarships to Northampton students who graduate with a 3.0 GPA or higher.
- 3. Provide the Northampton student with the opportunity to meet with a Cedar Crest representative for assistance with transferring to Cedar Crest prior to graduating from Northampton.

The signing of this agreement indicates the students' understanding of the following conditions:

- 1. Student shall have an earned high school diploma or its equivalent prior to signing a "Dual Admission Intent" form.
- 2. Student shall complete a "Dual Admission Intent" form available at the Advising and Transfer Office at Northampton.
- 3. Student shall complete no more than 30 credits of post-secondary academic course work prior to enrolling in the Cedar Crest-Northampton Dual Admission Program.
- 4. Student shall maintain a 2.00 cumulative grade point average for all post-secondary academic course work for general acceptance into Cedar Crest College. *Please note certain majors have minimum GPA requirements. Please consult with your advisor.*
- 5) Student shall graduate from Northampton with an Associate's degree. In addition, Cedar Crest College agrees to accept the general education credits embedded in the Northampton Community College Associate of Arts and Associate of Science degrees as meeting all the requirements of its undergraduate general education requirements.

 This core to core agreement applies to all Northampton Associate of Art and Associate of Science graduates, and is not limited to students who participate in the Dual Admissions Agreement. The Associate of Applied Science degree is not eligible for core-to-core consideration.
- 6) The Associate of Applied Science degree does not meet core-to-core requirements. In addition, Cedar Crest College agrees to review all completed coursework within the Associate of Applied Science degree, with the intent to transfer as many credits within Cedar Crest's transfer policies.
- 7) Student shall enroll at Cedar Crest College within one year of graduation from Northampton.
- 8) Student will not attend another post-secondary institution after graduating from Northampton and before enrolling at Cedar Crest College.

- 9) Student shall complete all admissions requirements within appropriate deadlines as determined by and to the satisfaction of Cedar Crest.
- 10) Male students are not eligible for the day admissions programs with the exception of Nursing and Nuclear Medicine Technology. See Appendix A for a list of programs.

You, the student, may void this agreement at any time with written notification to the Office of Admissions and Records at NCC.

Male students are not eligible for the day admissions programs with the exceptions of Nursing and Nuclear Medicine Technology. *Male students will make application to the School of Adult and Graduate Studies (SAGE). Female students graduated from high school four (4) or more years will make application to the School of Adult and Graduate Studies (SAGE).*

NOTE: Northampton CC students enrolled in the Dual Admission Program and participating in or attending activities, classes, and events at Cedar Crest will be subject to the rules and regulations governing all Cedar Crest students while on College property.
